## DVD or Book Request Forms

Surprised that Quatrefoil Library did not have available a certain book or DVD? The Acquisition Committee has made available a Request Form [Yellow (soon to be neon yellow) for DVDs and Goldenrod (soon to be neon orange) for Books] located at the left side of the check out desk. As some who already submitted the Form know, the turnaround time is NOT quick—in general, expect a couple of months if not more for the Library to acquire your request. And as noted on the form, funds may not be available (as is the case for the rest of 2010) to get the requested item.

The book or DVD must have at least a 10% LGBT content, OR a book written by an openly LGBT person. And because we are an all volunteer organization, and even though we do have some professional librarians as members of the Committee, we do not have the time to investigate whether the requested item meets the minimum 10% level. PLEASE attach an explanation with your request that gives the supporting information. This occurred when a person requested a book on Bundt cakes. As you are all aware, Bundt cakes have nothing to do with LGBT issues, but the person included an article that mentioned that the author lived in Roseville with her female partner. So we got the book. In regards to erotica DVDs, because the prices are usually high compared to "mainstream" DVDs and erotica is very subjective, we are currently not filling requests for them. We will hold on to those requests, until we generally have more total funds to use.

And last, but not least, with the explosion of books and DVDs dealing with LGBT issues, and most of our collection coming from donations, please take the opportunity to fill out the form so we can get things that you, our members, want to see. Thanks.
