THE YEAR IN REVIEW

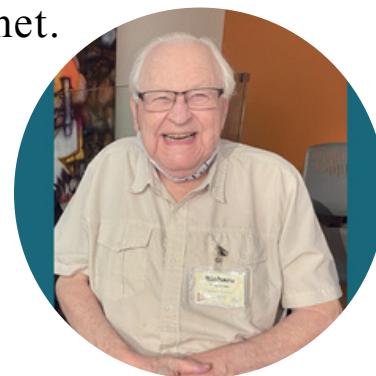
2025 grew the spotlight on Quatrefoil Library. The Minnesota Historical Society, with our collaboration, published an [article about the Library in MNopedia!](#) Twin Cities Amplified radio [interviewed](#) one of our longtime leaders and Librarians Karen Hogan alongside our Board President Ollin Montes about Quatrefoil Library.

2025 also brought heartbreak. Our community lost our last surviving co-founder, Dick Hewetson. Dick passed away on July 19th, 2025, in San Jose California. Dick was born on March 31st, 1930, and lived to the age of 95.

Dick lived an active and abundant life. Dick in partnership David Irwin incorporated Quatrefoil Library in 1983 and with the support of the community they opened our doors in 1986. Dick was actively involved the LGBTQIA+ community.

Dick participated in the fight to win the St. Paul Gay Right ordinance of 1977, served on the board of the Out and About Theatre a local gay theatre production company, and supported his union's organizing to include LGBTQIA+ protections in their contract. His later exploits included being an active member of the Freedom From Religion Foundation.

Dick's spirit of change and community continues as a living legacy through Quatrefoil Library. Many have and will continue to find inspiration, joy, and belonging at the Library because of you Dick, thank you. More information about Dick's life can be found at dickhewetson.net.



2025 Q HIGHLIGHTS

New Carpets in the Library

The Facilities Committee and the Librarian Advisory Group coordinated with Trellis building management, Hamernick's Flooring, and Bester Bros Moving Company to replace Quatrefoil's carpet. The project was completed efficiently and many volunteers assisted with packing and unpacking the Library during the project.

Expanding the Collection

In 2025, 203 new digital titles were added to the Libby collection, and 166 new physical titles were added to the Library collection. New titles included Letters from a New Utopia: Reclaiming Liberation from Palestine to the World by Yaffa AS and A Body Made Home by Kai Marshall Green.

Q in MNopedia

Volunteers at Quatrefoil partnered with the Minnesota Historical Society through interviews, research, and pulling pieces from our archive to create an entry for the Library in MNopedia, a resource for reliable information about significant people, places, events and things in Minnesota history.

2025 Q HIGHLIGHTS

Outstanding Community Partner

In August 2025, Quatrefoil received the Outstanding New Community Partner Award for our support and collaboration with the Center for Community-Engaged Learning at the University of Minnesota. We provided volunteer opportunities for students in the Community Engaged Learning program for the 2024-2025 school year. Students volunteered for 15-20 hours each and participated in a number of tasks, including Zine making, cataloging, book processing and subject heading work.

We continue to see the use of our collection increase, with new members and new titles coming to the Library regularly. Our most popular titles this year were Somewhere Beyond the Sea by TJ Klune and Boys, Beasts, & Men by Sam J. Miller.

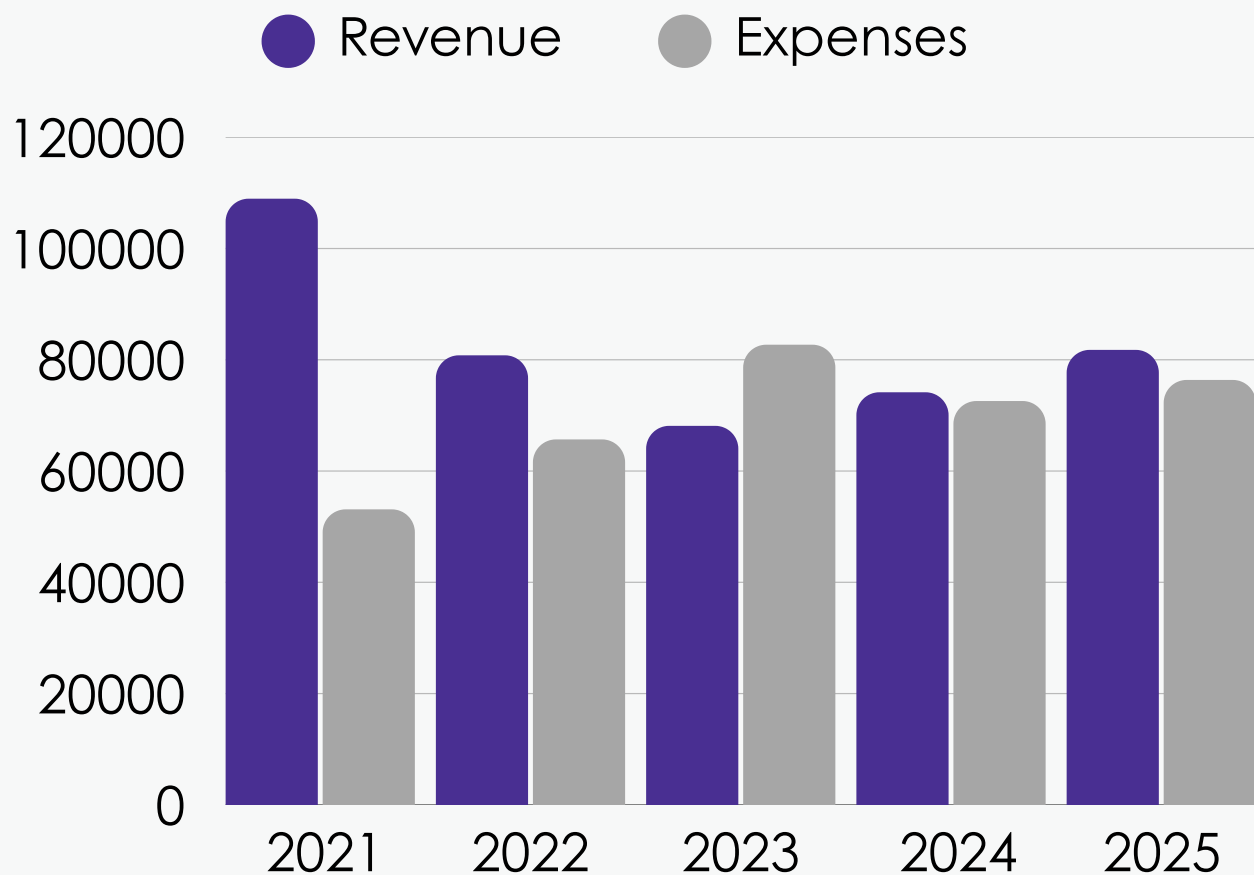
3886 Digital Titles Checked Out

2025 QUATREFOIL FINANCIAL SUMMARY

The Library ended the year with a surplus of \$5,402. This surplus came in part from the Library experiencing a decrease in certain expenses, a contribution from our endowment fund, and an increase in support from our donors. We continued to invest in our community and our collection on course with previous years.

Quatrefoil ended 2025 with an increase of \$101,821 in total assets from 2024. Total assets increased to \$860,080.



LOOKING FORWARD

Next year will serve as a bridge between the past and the future.

2026 will be our fortieth anniversary! We are excited to enter a fifth decade in the community. We expect to have a major fundraising event as well as anniversary projects and opportunities to celebrate and reflect on our history and accomplishments. This will also include unveiling two panels about our history designed and produced by the Minnesota Historical Society.

We will also prepare for our future. The Board over the last year prospected organizations to partner with the Library in developing a set of strategic priorities for the next 3-5 years. We will finalize a contract with AORTA, a co-operative of social justice facilitators and consultants in early 2026 to work with us in the coming year.

The size of the board will grow! 5 new board members will join us in early 2026. We wait eagerly their new perspectives, talent and excitement
